Today's Program: Scholarship, Inc. Scholarship Recipients

The Fort Walton Beach Rotary Club through the Fort Walton Beach Rotary Club Scholarship, Inc. (FWBRCSI) annually funds and awards scholarships to bright, local students helping to prepare them for productive, successful lives. FWBRCSI is responsible for all domestic scholarship activities of the Fort Walton Beach Rotary Club and is a registered 501(C)3 non-profit organization. Since its inception FWBRCSI had disbursed approximately \$730,000 to over 460 deserving local students. Three categories of scholarships are awarded annually. The number of scholarships awarded in each category is determined by the FWBRCSI Board of Directors. Funds awarded through the scholarships may be used for tuition and books. Scholarships may be renewed.

- **Kay Stokes Memorial Nursing Scholarship**— Kay Stokes was a registered nurse and pediatrics practitioner who recognized there would be a dire shortage of nurses and efforts to fill this void were needed. She was the wife of the late Randy Stokes, a member of our club. This scholarship is awarded to qualified persons entering the field of nursing or related medical fields.
- **James Sutton Scholarship**—James Sutton was a long-time Rotarian who was extremely interested in the education of our young people. This scholarship is awarded to degree-seeking students. The field of study is unrestricted.
- **John T Morgan III Memorial Scholarship**—John T Morgan III is the late son of Rotarian John Morgan, Jr. At 18 he was diagnosed with a malignant brain tumor. During the ensuing 5 years he remained cheerful, helpful and loving to his family and friends. In spite of multiple surgeries, radiation, extensive medication and tremendous side effects, his greatest desire was to help people. This scholarship is awarded to a student who has overcome great adversity in his or her life, whether it be an illness, disability or other special situation.
