THE JOHN T. MORGAN III MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

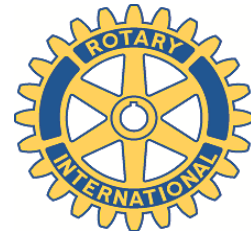
The scholarship is named in memory of the son of Rotarian John Morgan, Jr. "Little John" as John T. Morgan III was known, graduated from Fort Walton Beach High School Class of 1985. John suffered a brain tumor at the age of 18 and through his cheerful attitude and courageous spirit he outlived the odds for 5 years and overcame great adversity.



The John T. Morgan III Memorial Scholarship is awarded annually to a student who has overcome great adversity in his/her life whether it is due to illness, handicap, or other special need. The applicant must be a senior at one of the three applicable high schools and have a cumulative 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
