Today's Guest Speaker: **Chuck Shanklin, Pres.** **Crestview Aerospace**



Charles R. Shanklin is the President of Crestview Aerospace Corporation. In his position, Shanklin

oversees the daily operations, strategic planning and positioning for the corporation's long-term growth. Crestview Aerospace has grown from a 13 employee Company in 1991 to a 1,175 employee company with \$85 million in revenue in 2005.

Established in 1964, Crestview Aerospace Corporation remains a privately held company strategically positioned as a leading supplier of aircraft modifications and manufacturing for commercial and government aircraft. As an aerospace supplier, Crestview Aerospace Corporation is involved in both the production of new aircraft structures, and the modification of fixed and rotor wing aircraft.

Shanklin's involvement with the aviation industry began in 1988 with Artais, an AWOS manufacturer located in Columbus, Ohio. As Marketing Manager, Shanklin established successful relationships with the FAA and obtained market leadership for Artais,

gaining 35 percent of industry market share. In 1990, Shanklin became president of Artais, where he led the firm's growth from \$1 – 8 million in annual revenues in just six years. With Chuck Shanklin as President, Artais grew its market share from 35 percent to 80 percent. Artais' growth under Shanklin's leadership attracted the attention of Helsinki, Finland-based Vaisala. Following a merger in 1996, Shanklin stayed on as director of Vaisala-Artais Division. He led cooperative efforts between both companies, and orchestrated several initiatives for the newly formed company to increase opportunities nationally and internationally.

Shanklin joined Crestview Aerospace Corporation as Vice President, Aircraft Modification Division in 1998. Since his arrival, Shanklin has focused on developing strategic alliances with Prime Contractors to the Department of Defense including Boeing, Bell, L-3, Lockheed Martin and Northrop Grumman. He has also served as a board member of Crestview Aerospace Corporation since 1991. In June 2004, board members promoted Chuck Shanklin to President of Crestview Aerospace Corporation.

Do You Know....*the different types of membership?*

There are two types of Rotary club membership — active and honorary. An active member is one who has been elected to membership in the club under a classification of business or profession and enjoys all the obligations, responsibilities, and privileges of membership as provided in the RI constitution and bylaws. Active members may hold office in their clubs and serve RI at the district and international levels. They are expected to meet attendance requirements, pay dues, and bring new members into Rotary.

Honorary Rotary membership may be offered to people who have distinguished themselves by meritorious service in the furtherance of Rotary ideals. An honorary member is elected for one year only, and continuing membership must be renewed annually. Honorary members cannot propose new members to the club or hold office and are

exempt from attendance requirements and club dues.

Many distinguished heads of state, explorers, authors, musicians, astronauts, and other public personalities have been honorary members of Rotary clubs, including King Gustaf of Sweden, King George VI of England, King Badouin of Belgium, King Hassan III of Morocco, Sir Winston Churchill, humanitarian Albert Schweitzer, Charles Lindbergh, composer Jean Sibelius, explorer Sir Edmund Hillary, Thor Heyerdahl, Thomas Edison, Walt Disney, Bob Hope, Dr. Albert Sabin, British Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher, and many of the presidents of the United States.
