Today's Guest Speaker: Ted Litschauer, Chief

Fort Walton Beach Police Department



Chief Litschauer was named Fort Walton Beach Police Chief and was sworn in on January 30th 2006. He began his law enforcement career

as a sworn reserve law enforcement officer for the Manatee County (Florida) Sheriff's Office in April, 1973. That same year he became a full-time deputy sheriff. He progressed through the ranks as a Patrolman, Detective, Detective First Class, Sergeant, Detective Sergeant and Lieutenant.

Chief Litschauer joined the Tampa (Florida) Police Department in January, 1990 as a Patrolman, serving in Uniform District 1. After serving in various special assignments, and in just twenty-five months, he was promoted to the rank of Commander, to serve as the Division Commander of one of Tampa's six divisions. He coordinated two career paths simultaneously from 1980 to 1993. He continued in law enforcement service, part-time from 1980 to 1986 and full-time from 1990 to 1993, while at the same time operating his own commercial and residential construction company.

Chief Litschauer became Chief of the City of Sedalia, Missouri Police De-

partment, where he served for 10 and one half years from 1995 to 2006. He was recognized by various agencies and groups throughout Missouri for his leadership and enhancement of law enforcement in Missouri.

Chief Litschauer received an Associate of Arts Degree in Mathematics from Manatee Junior College in 1968; later receiving a Bachelor of Arts Degree, cum laude, in Political Science from the University of West Florida in 1970. He also holds a Masters of Science Degree, "as a Dean's Scholar", in Criminal Justice from Nova University in 1979. He graduated as Valedictorian from The University of Louisville's international police executive development center: The Southern Police Institute's Administrative Officers Course, 91st Session, in 1994; and graduated from the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (FBI) CS-LEEDS (Law Enforcement Executive Development School) in 2000.

Ted is married to his wife Linda and they will celebrate thirty years of marriage in June of this year. They have two children; their daughter Marie who is serving in the United States Air Force; and son Ted Jr. who is a senior at Central Missouri State University.
