Today's Guest Speaker: Col. Edmond B. Keith *Commander, 96th Air Base Wing, Eglin AFB*



Colonel Edmond B. Keith is the commander of the 96th Air Base Wing, Air Force Materiel Command at Eglin Air Force Base.

As Eglin's host wing commander, Col. Keith is responsible for the Department of Defense's largest installation, 724 square miles (slightly smaller than the state of Rhode Island), facilities and equipment valued in excess of \$13B. He leads 5,000 men and women in providing essential base operating support to the more than 16,000 personnel assigned to the Air Armament Center, seven wings, 50 associate units and executes an annual budget of over \$125M. He directs the daily operations of the Air Force's largest installation mobility commitment and is Air Force Materiel Command's Lead Wing for Expeditionary Combat Support. Under his direct command are four distinct groups and seventeen squadrons and divisions; the Air Force's largest Civil Engineer war fighting unit and Explosive Ordnance Disposal flight; the Air Force's largest Supply function; the Air Force's fifth largest hospital coupled with its fourth largest medical mobility commitment; the Air Force's largest

Transportation function in the CONUS; one of four Air Force Ground Combat Training Squadrons, and one of two Department of Defense units to achieve level five software engineering status.

Colonel Keith graduated from Brookland Cayce High School, Cayce, S.C. in 1978, was commissioned in 1982 through the Reserve Officer Training Corps at the Virginia Military Institute and is an in-residence graduate from the Air War College. He has spent his entire Air Force career in civil engineering, with tours at every level of command: HQ USAF, MAJCOM, and field. He spent the first of his civil engineer tours as an electrical engineer at Pope Air Force Base, N.C. Colonel Keith then commanded the 314th Civil Engineer Squadron at Little Rock Air Force Base, Ark; the 1st Civil Engineer Squadron at Langley Air Force Base, Va. and the 89th Mission Support Group at Andrews Air Force Base, Md. Prior to his current position, the colonel was the civil engineer for Air Force Special Operations Command at Hurlburt Field, Fla.

Col. Keith earned a Bachelor of science degree in electrical engineering from the Virginia Military Institute, Lexington, VA in 1982; and a Master of science degree in electrical engineering from North Carolina State University, Raleigh, N.C. in 1985. ■

Do You Know...*the importance of regular attendance?*

The Standard Rotary Club Constitution specifies three conditions under which a Rotarian's membership will automatically be terminated for nonattendance. These circumstances are: failure to attend or make up four consecutive club meetings, failure to attend or make up 60 percent of club meetings each six months, and failure to attend at least 30 percent of the meetings of one's own club in each six-month period. Under any of these three cases, a member will lose Rotary membership unless the club board of directors has previously consented to excuse such failure for good and sufficient reason.

When a member misses four consecutive regular meetings, the board will inform him or her that nonattendance may be considered a request to terminate membership in the club. Thereafter, the board, by a majority vote, may terminate his or her membership.

To some individuals, these rules may seem unusually rigid. However, being present at club meetings is one of the basic obligations a member accepts upon joining a Rotary club. The constitutional rules merely emphasize that Rotary is a participatory organization that highly values regular attendance. When a member is absent the entire club loses the personal association with that member. Being present at a club meeting is considered a vital part of the operation and success of every Rotary club.
