Today's Guest Speaker: Joyce Gossom, Ph.D.

Director of Branch Campuses, University of West Florida

Dr. Joyce Gossom will speak to us today about the Fort Walton Beach Community Redevelopment Agency of the City of Fort Walton Beach, of which she is a member and past chairperson.

Dr. Gossom was born in Chicago, Illinois. She received a bachelor of science degree in special education from Illinois State University in 1978, a master of education degree in adult education and supervision from Georgia Southern University in 1992, and an education doctorate in curriculum and instruction from the University of West Florida in December 2004.

Dr. Gossom has worked in academic and corporate professions

as a special education teacher, a management consultant, an instructional designer, a program development supervisor, and as a higher education instructor and administrator.

In 1992, Dr. Gossom founded a management consulting company which she merged with her husband's communication firm in 1998. In 2004, she joined the University of West Florida. She currently serves as the Director of Branch Campuses for UWF. Throughout her professional career, Dr. Gossom has been involved with numerous civic and community organizations as a member and on the Board of Directors.

Do You Know...about Interact and Wheelettes?

Interact, Rotary-sponsored youth service club, was launched by the RI Board of Directors in 1962. The first Interact club was established by the Rotary Club of Melbourne, Florida, USA. Interact clubs provide opportunities for young people of secondary school age to work together in a world fellowship of service and international understanding. The term "Interact" is derived from "inter;' for international, "act," for action. Every Interact club must be sponsored and supervised by a Rotary club and must plan annual projects of service to its school, community, and the world.

Today, there are more than 8,600 Interact clubs with about 200,000 members in some 110 countries. Interactors develop skills in leadership and attain

practical experience in conducting service projects, thereby learning the satisfaction that comes from serving others. A major goal of Interact is to provide opportunities for young people to create greater understanding and goodwill with youth throughout the world.


