Today's Guest: Honorable Ray Sansom Representative, Florida House of Representatives, District 4



We are proud to have the Honorable Ray Sansom, Representative, Florida House of Representatives, District 4, as our special guest speaker today.

Representative Sansom was elected to the Florida House of Representatives in November of 2002 and reelected without opposition in 2004. Representative Sansom has been selected by his colleagues to serve as Florida's Speaker of the House in November 2008-2010. He is currently Chairman of the House Transportation Committee and serves on the Rules and Calendar Council, State Infrastructure Council, Transportation Appropriations Committee and Governmental Operations Committee. During Representative Sansom's first term, he was Chair of the Joint Legislative Auditing Committee and a member of 14 other committees.

Representative Sansom was elected to the Okaloosa County Commission in 1992 and re-elected without opposition in 1996. He was Chairman of the commission four of the eight years he served. Representative San-

som was a Legislative Assistant in both the Florida House of Representatives and Florida Senate before elected to the County Commission. Representative Sansom was presented the "President's Award" in 1999 by the Florida City and County Managers Association, being the first County Commissioner to receive this honor. Representative Sansom was also selected "Freshman Legislator of the Year" by the Association of Counties in 2003.

Representative Sansom is currently employed by the Okaloosa School District as the Director of Community Affairs. Representative Sansom serves on the Emerald Coast YMCA Board of Directors, Board of Directors of Vanguard Bank and other community boards. Ray holds a Master's Degree in Educational Leadership from the University of West Florida, Bachelor's Degree in Political Science from Florida State University, and an Associates of Art's Degree from Okaloosa-Walton Junior College. He is a native of Okaloosa County; and is married to the former Tricia Raimey and they have three daughters, Jessica, Carlee and Julia.

Do You Know... the international responsibilities of Rotarians?

As an international organization, Rotary offers each member unique opportunities and responsibilities. Although each Rotarian has first responsibility to uphold the obligations of citizenship of his or her own country, membership in Rotary enables Rotarians to take a somewhat different view of international affairs. In the early 1950s, a Rotary philosophy was adopted to describe how a Rotarian may think on a global basis. Here is what it said:

"A world-minded Rotarian:

- looks beyond national patriotism and considers himself as sharing responsibility for the advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace;
- resists any tendency to act in terms of national or racial superiority;
- seeks and develops common grounds for agreement with peoples of other lands;
- defends the rule of law and order to preserve the liberty of the individual so that he may enjoy freedom of thought, speech, and assembly, and freedom from persecution, aggression, want, and fear;
- · supports action directed toward improv-

- ing standards of living for all peoples, realizing that poverty anywhere endangers prosperity everywhere;
- upholds the principles of justice for mankind;
- strives always to promote peace between nations and prepares to make personal sacrifices for that ideal;
- urges and practices a spirit of understanding of others' beliefs as a step toward international goodwill, recognizing that there are certain basic moral and spiritual standards which will ensure a richer, fuller life."

That is quite an assignment for any Rotarian to practice in thoughts and actions!

When this philosophy was developed, Rotary was still an all-male organization. The description of a world-minded Rotarian today would obviously include all women members as well.
