## TODAY'S GUEST: Dr. E. Gaylon McCollough

M.D., F.A.C.S., Founder, McCollough Institute For Appearance & Health



Dr. Gaylon McCollough is our guest speaker today and will talk to us about "Health, Beauty and Success: A time-tested formula."

Since entering practice, Dr. E. Gaylon McCollough has obtained international recognition as a surgeon and teacher. He is the co-author of several major textbooks on facial and nasal plastic surgery.

Dr. McCollough completed an approved program of specialized training in **facial plastic surgery** in Beverly Hills, California; New Orleans, Louisiana; and Boston, Massachusetts... and is "board-certified" by The American Board of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery and has served as the Board's President. He is also certified by the American Board of Otolaryngology, ("representing the specialty of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery").

Dr. McCollough was also inducted into the American Board of Cosmetic Surgery as an honorary member and served as president of the American Association of Cosmetic Surgeons and the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery.

Dr. McCollough has traveled to India, Columbia, Germany, England, Canada, Italy, Mexico, Australia, South Africa and Spain to teach seminars and techniques of head and neck plastic surgery to sur-

geons from around the world. Dr. McCollough has been included in *The Best Doctors in America®*, since 1994.

After 25 successful years in Birmingham, One of *The Best Doctors in America®*, Nasal and Facial Plastic Surgeon, E. Gaylon McCollough, M.D., F.A.C.S. and the internationally acclaimed McCollough Plastic Surgery Clinic moved to Gulf Shores, Alabama, where he founded the 35,000 square foot **McCollough Institute For Appearance & Health**, an interdisciplinary professional complex dedicated to helping people from all walks of life look, feel, and perform better...longer. The McCollough Institute was honored by the Alabama Gulf Coast Chamber of Commerce as "Business of the Year" 2002.

Dr. McCollough was an Academic All-American center on Alabama Coach Paul "Bear" Bryant's 1964 National Championship Team.

Dr. McCollough was honored by the March of Dimes as Alabama Citizen of the Year for 1994-1995, and is listed in the National Registry of Who's Who in Medicine.

Dr. McCollough and his wife, Susan, have two children and four grandchildren. ■

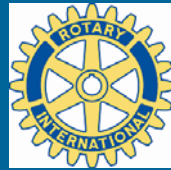
