We are proud to have the Honorable Charlie Clary, Senator and President Pro Tempore, as our special guest speaker today.

Senator Clary was elected to the Florida Senate in November of 1996 and re-elected in 2000 and 2002. Senator Clary was elected Majority Whip in 2001-02 and President Pro Tempore in November, 2004 for a two year term. He is currently Chairman of the General Government Appropriations Committee and other committee memberships include: Community Affairs; Judiciary; Rules and Calendar; Transportation; Ways and Means; Public Service Commission Oversight; and the select Committee on Medicaid Reform.

Prior to serving in the Florida Senate, Senator Clary was a Destin City Council Member for six years.

Senator Clary is a founding Principal for DAG Architects Inc., and has over twenty-five years experience in architectural design and project management. The American Institute of Architects has recognized Mr. Clary's contribution to architecture and public service, first, as a City Council member for the City of Destin, and then as a State Senator by his elevation to Fellowship of the Institute in 2000. As one of 102 Fellows in the State of Florida, he has been admitted to the leadership of the profession in this state. He also received a Component Excellence Award from the Institute in 1999.

Senator Clary served in the US Navy: Submarine Service. He is a graduate of Auburn University with a Bachelor of Architecture in 1977 and a Bachelor of Environmental Design in 1976. He is a native of Okaloosa County, and is married to the former Beth Graham, who is a retired teacher. They have two grown daughters, Joanna and Laura. ■

The Rotary Volunteers program operates under the umbrella of Vocational Service at the club, district, and international level. Rotarians and non-Rotarians who wish to serve as international volunteers can register with RI World.

teers Resource List can help volunteers locate their own projects and make arrangements directly with project coordinators.

The Rotary Foundation provides funds, to cover air transportation and a modest per diem, to registered Rotary Volunteers who are Rotarians, Rotar-actors, and qualified Foundation alumni and who have an invitation from a Rotary club in the host country. Volunteers do not receive a salary or honorarium for their services. Rotary Volunteers have shared their expertise in a multitude of humanitarian projects around the world.
