Today's Guest Speaker: The Honorable Judge Patt Maney



Judge Patt Maney has been Okaloosa County Court judge since 1989. He has handled numerous high profile cases as well as

being "the people's judge". He's noted for his problem solving approach to systemic problems including jail overcrowding, the cost of incarcerating mentally ill citizens and worthless checks. In over 18 years on the bench, he has stressed professional courtesy and honesty and has mentored many young attorneys. In addition to his judicial responsibilities, he serves on the statewide DUI Programs Review Board. While maturing as a judge, he simultaneously continued to serve in the Army Reserve, ultimately retiring as a brigadier general in April, 2007.

General Maney is a veteran of Operation Just Cause (Panama), Operation Uphold Democracy (Haiti), Operations Joint Guard and Joint Endeavor (Bosnia) and Operation Enduring Freedom (Afghanistan). For 17

months, BG Maney served as the Political Sector Coordinator and Senior Advisor to the US Ambassador and held the diplomatic status of attaché. He was wounded in an IED attack becoming the senior service member to be wounded in Afghanistan. He later spent almost 20-months at Walter Reed Army Medical Center. Among his awards are the Legion of Merit with one oak leaf cluster and the Purple Heart. He also holds the Secretary of Defense Award for Outstanding Public Service, the Department of State's Meritorious Honor Award and the Afghan Ghazi Mir Batcha Khan Superior Medal that was presented by the late king, Zahir Shah.

An Eagle Scout and holder of the Scouts' God and Country Award, Judge Maney is a graduate of the University of Kentucky, the University of Louisville College of Law, Troy State University and the Army War College. He has taught legal and banking courses at the University of West Florida and Okaloosa Walton College. He and his wife of 36-years, Caroline, have two grown daughters and three grandchildren. One son-in-law recently returned from serving his second tour in Iraq.

Judge Maney is a Kentuckian by birth, an Anglican by profession of faith and a Christian by Grace. ■
