Born and raised locally on the Emerald Coast, Brian Lambert began racing small catamarans at the early age of 12 with his older brother John, whom he

tragically lost in a car accident back in 1991. Since that time, he has continued to excel in the sport of multihull catamaran racing and was recognized in 2003 as the All-Sports Amateur Athlete of Year.

His experience in the sport is extensive, and has taken him to locations around the world with competitions in Canada, US Virgin Islands, Netherland Antilles, Brazil, Italy, France, Germany, and Poland to name a few. Brian holds several National titles in various classes of multihulls including: Hobie 17', Hobie 20', Nacra 6.0', Nacra Inter 20', and Corsair 28R. He is also a veteran of the world class

Worrell 1000 Adventure Race, (competing 6 times winning 3) and he is the current reigning Champion of the event. Most recently, he had competed in California last summer winning the 2007 Hobie 20' Nationals after a week long event in San Francisco.

Mr. Lambert currently resides in Fort Walton Beach

with his beautiful and supportive wife, Julie and his three lovely children
