Today's Program: Rotary Youth Exchange Theresa Kesseler and Abby Chapman

Today's Guest Speakers are Theresa Kessler and Abby Chapman, Rotary Youth Exchange participants to and from Germany.

Youth Exchange is one of the most popular programs to promote international understanding and develop lifelong friendships. It began in 1927 with the Rotary Club of Nice, France. Exchanges in Europe continued until World War II and resumed after the war in 1946. In 1939, an extensive Youth Exchange was created between California and Latin America. Since then, the program has expanded around the world. In recent years, more than 7,000 young people have participated annually in Rotary cluband district-sponsored exchange programs.

The values of Youth Exchange are experienced not only by the high-schoolage students involved but also by the host families, sponsoring clubs, receiving high schools, and the entire community. Youth Exchange participants usually provide their fellow students in their host schools with excellent opportunities to learn about customs, languages, traditions, and family life in another country.


Youth Exchange offers young people interesting opportunities and rich experiences to see another part of the world. Students usually spend a full academic year abroad, although some

clubs and districts sponsor short-term exchanges of several weeks or months.

Youth Exchange is a highly recommended program for all Rotary clubs as a practical activity for the enhancement of international understanding and goodwill.

ABCs of Rotary......Sponsoring a New Member

The bylaws of Rotary clearly outline the procedure • for proposing someone for Rotary club membership. bers each week for the first month. The "proposer" or sponsor is the key person in the growth and advancement of Rotary. Without a sponsor, an individual will never have the opportunity to become a Rotarian. Individuals must be asked to join Rotary; thus, it is every member's responsibility to identify and invite prospective members.

The task of the sponsor should not end merely by as Group Study Exchange or Youth Exchange. submitting a name to the club secretary or membership committee. Rotary has not established formal responsibilities for sponsors; however, these procedures are recommended in many clubs.

The sponsor should

- Invite a prospective member to several meetings prior to proposing the individual for membership.
- Accompany the prospective new member to one or more orientation/informational meetings.

- Introduce the new member to other club mem-
- Encourage the new member to become involved in any club service projects underway.
- Invite the new member to attend meetings of the Interact or Rotaract clubs sponsored by the
- Provide opportunities for the new member to get involved in international program efforts, such
- Invite the new member to accompany the sponsor to neighboring clubs for the first make-up meeting to learn the process and observe the spirit of friendship.
- Ask the new member and spouse to accompany the sponsor to the club's social activities, dinners, or other special occasions
- Urge the new member and spouse to attend the district conference with the sponsor.
- Serve as a special friend to assure that the new member becomes an active Rotarian.
