Today's guest speaker is Charlotte Dunworth. Mrs. Dunworth will speak to the Club about her participation in a Group Study Exchange trip to Nice, France.

Charlotte Dunworth is the Budget & Grants Manager for the City of Fort Walton Beach. She graduated from the University of Florida in May 2000 with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration with a major in Finance and a minor in Economics. Charlotte was a financial analyst at Rockwell Collins before moving to Fort Walton Beach in May 2002. Her current responsibilities include developing, amending, and administering Fort Walton Beach's \$36.6 million budget; preparing monthly financial reports; monitoring grants activity; recommending investment strategies; and performing other special projects as needed.

Charlotte was recognized by her peers

for her work with FEMA after Hurricane Ivan and awarded Employee of the Year in 2005, and was a finalist for the Florida League of Cities' Employee of the Year program in 2006. She is a member of the Leadership Okaloosa class of 2008.

Actively involved in the Florida Government Finance Officers Association (FGFOA), Charlotte has served on the Board of the Panhandle Chapter FGFOA for 2 ½ years and will assume the Presidency in April 2009. She has also been a member of the career development committee for the State FGFOA and is currently chairing the ad hoc committee developing a fiscal survivor series seminar. Charlotte also serves as a budget reviewer for the national Government Finance Officers Association.

In her spare time, Charlotte enjoys playing tennis and traveling. She and her husband are the USTA local league coordinators for the Emerald Coast area for mixed doubles leagues in the summer and combo doubles leagues in the fall. ■

ABCs of Rotary.....The Object of Rotary

In some areas of the world weekly Rotary club meetings begin with all members standing and reciting the Object of Rotary. This statement, which comes from the Constitution of Rotary, is frequently seen on a wall plaque in Rotarians' offices or place of business. The Object of Rotary is "to encourage and foster the ideal of service as a basis of worthy enterprise." The statement then lists four areas by which this "ideal of service" is fostered: through the development of acquaintance as the opportunity for service; the promotion of high ethical standards in business and professions; through service in one's personal, business and community life; and the advancement of international understanding, goodwill and peace.

The Object of Rotary has not always been expressed in this manner. The original Constitution of 1906 had three objects: promotion of business interests, promotion of good fellowship and the

advancement of the best interests of the community. By 1910 Rotary had five Objects as increased emphasis was given to expanding Rotary. By 1915 there were six Objects. In 1918 the Objects were rewritten again and reduced to four. Four years later they had again grown to six and were revised again in 1927.

Finally, at the 1935 Mexico City Convention the six Objects were restated and reduced to four. The last major change came in 1951, when the "Objects" were streamlined and changed to a single "Object" which is manifested in four separate ways. The "ideal of service" is the key phrase in the Object of Rotary. This ideal is an attitude of being a thoughtful and helpful person in all of one's endeavors. That's what the Object truly means.
