To be located next to the National Naval Aviation Museum, the NFA will be an exciting, state-of-the-art environment for 7-12th grade students. The facility itself will be modeled similar to the inside of an aircraft carrier, while the core subjects will include naviga-

tion, meteorology, aerodynamics, propulsion and flight physiology. Lessons and experiences at the NFA and the Museum will complement each other to create a dynamic experience for participating students and their families.

In addition to educating our nation's youth and drawing more visitors to Pensacola, the NFA will also create countless jobs for area citizens, with an immediate economic impact in excess of \$30 million for the Pensacola region. Families from all over the world will converge along the Gulf Coast, increasing local tourism and revenue.
