Between Active Duty Army, Army Reserve, Army National Guard I have over 19 years of service. I moved to Fort Walton Beach in 2004 after hurricane Ivan to open a Chiropractic clinic. During which time I was a member of the Missouri Army National Guard as a

company commander of an AH-64A unit. I transferred to the Mississippi Army National guard into the position of company commander for I Company 185th Aviation based in Gulfport, MS. In March of 2008 I was sent to Fort Rucker, AL to transition from rotor wing to fixed wing aircraft, there I was qualified in the C-12 King Air. After the C-12 transition I was immediately sent to New York and West Virginia for the C-23 Sherpa qualification course. In October of 2008 ,I was mobilized as the company commander for I Co 185th AVN to deploy to Iraq to conduct Army Airlift Support. I deployed with 45 soldiers under my command and return with each of them.
