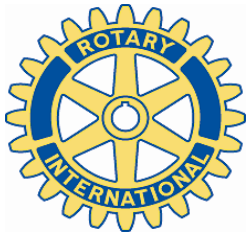

Greg Donovan

Okaloosa County Airports Director



Greg Donovan is the director of Okaloosa County's three airports consisting of Northwest Florida Regional Airport, Destin Airport, and Bob Sikes/Crestview Airport.

Northwest Florida Regional Airport is a joint-use facility located on Eglin AFB that accommodates over 750,000 passengers annually on five airlines. Home to over thirty companies, Northwest Florida Regional has an annual economic impact of over \$466 million into the local economy. Bob Sikes/Crestview Airport is an industrial airport with an 8,000 foot ILS runway providing a business environment for major aerospace companies such as L-3 Communications and BAE Systems. Destin Airport is a primary access point for a coastal resort community with over 65,000 annual operations of business and private aircraft annually.

Prior to being appointed to this position in January 2008, Greg was the Assistant Airport Director at Pensacola Regional Airport for 7 years and oversaw the Airport Police Department, Operations Division, and Maintenance Division of the small-hub facility.

From 1992 to 2001 Greg was the Operations Manager at Dane County Regional Airport in Madison, Wisconsin. He has also worked for the Houston Airport System at Hobby Airport (1991), America West Airlines corporate headquarters in Phoenix, Arizona (1991), and with the Federal Aviation Administration at Orlando International Airport (1989).

He earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Aviation Management from Florida Institute of Technology in 1991, professional accreditation from the American Association of Airport Executives (AAAE) earned in 2004, and holds a private pilot's license.

Donovan served as President of the Wisconsin Airport Management Association (WAMA) in 2001, graduated from Leadership Pensacola in 2003, served on the USO board of directors 2004 to 2008, and attended the 2009 National Security Forum at Maxwell AFB. Donovan was an Honorary Commander with the 33d Fighter Wing at Eglin AFB from 2008 to 2009 and was selected by Gen. Davis as a community ambassador for 2010.

He currently serves as vice president of the Florida Airports Council (FAC) and chairs the Northwest Region of the Continuing Florida Aviation Systems Planning Process (CFASPP). He has been married to his wife Jennifer for 16 years and they are the proud parents of two boys – Ryan (9) and Kyle (7).

BELL RINGING, LANDMARK LIGHTING TO MARK ROTARY'S 106TH ANNIVERSARY

Rotary International will join Sanofi Pasteur, a leading provider of polio vaccine, in ringing the opening bell in four financial markets in Europe on 23 February, in honor of Rotary's 106th anniversary and in support of a polio-free world.

R.I. President Ray Klingensmith will also ring the closing bell at the New York Stock Exchange in New York City.

Representatives of the two organizations will take part in openings in Lisbon, Portugal; Amsterdam; Brussels, Belgium; and Paris. The stock exchange ceremonies represent the first time the bell will be rung for a single cause in all five markets.

As the largest company in the world devoted entirely to human vaccines, Sanofi Pasteur has played a major role in the effort to push polio to the brink of eradication. Sanofi has contributed millions of doses of the oral polio vaccine to the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, of which Rotary is a spearheading partner, along with the World Health Organization, the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and UNICEF. Since 1988, the company has donated 120 million doses of oral polio vaccine for the immunization of children in war-ravaged Angola, Liberia, Sierra Leone, Somalia, and Southern Sudan.
