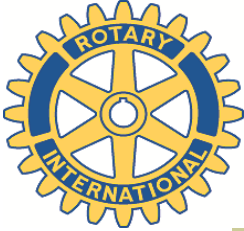

ROTARY YOUTH CAMP

Rotary Youth Camp, Inc. (RYC) was incorporated in 1995 to offer a camp program for children with disabilities. RYC provides an overnight summer camp experience to children with special needs who have conditions such as spina bifida, muscular dystrophy, cerebral palsy, hearing and seeing impairments, neuromuscular disorders, Down syndrome, autism, and spinal cord injuries. The camp facility is located 25 miles west of Tallahassee.

Many of the campers find it difficult, if not, impossible to attend other camps. Eighty percent of the first-time campers have never attended a camp of any kind or even spent a night away from home. Last summer RYC was able to have two one-week sessions divided by age groups and to serve sixty-one campers. New camper applications are already coming in, and we are looking forward to having even more this summer.

RYC gives these special children a chance to enjoy activities such as swimming, scuba diving, riding horses, archery, fishing, and singing karaoke. We also have daily arts and crafts, recreation, special projects based on our theme for the summer, and end the week with a “dress up” dance.

Our counselor-to-camper ratio is 1:2. We have an over 80% return rate for both campers and counselors. The staff includes many with disabilities and several who were themselves former campers.
