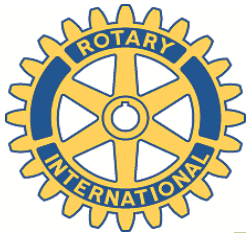

Dr. Ty Handy began his presidency of Northwest Florida State College in June 2010. He is a Florida native and most recently served as the President of Vermont Technical College, a public associate and baccalaureate institution. Dr. Handy previously served as Chancellor of Ivy Tech Community College in Southern Indiana, a comprehensive two-year community and technical college in the Ivy Tech Community College System.

Dr. Handy earned his doctorate (Ed.D.) degree from the University of Memphis in Higher Education Administration, an MBA in Accounting and Finance from Drexel University and a Baccalaureate degree in Finance from Western Kentucky University. Other academic positions Dr. Handy has held include Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs at the University of Arkansas Community College – Batesville; Dean of Academic Affairs at Elizabethtown Community College in Kentucky, and Dean of Business Technologies/Social Sciences at Jefferson Community College, Ohio.

Dr. Handy and his wife, Kim, are the proud parents of two sons, Jon, a graduate student at the University of Alabama and Beau, a senior at Western Kentucky University.

DESTIN BBQ CHALLENGE

Our club is participating in the 2nd Annual BBQ Challenge being sponsored by the Rotary Club of Destin. The event will take place at Harborwalk Village (Emerald Grande) in Destin on Aug. 13-14th.

We are pre-selling slow cooked smoked pork ribs (with sauce or with only seasoning) for \$25 per rack and pork butts for \$40. This fundraiser will provide financial support for our local and international service projects. Judging of the BBQ is to occur sometime between 2:00 and 3:30 PM on Saturday, Aug. 14th. Every member of our club is encouraged to sell 10 racks or butts. The BBQ crew will be at Harborwalk nearly around the clock from Friday afternoon until Saturday night but help is also needed during the pre-cooking we will do earlier in the week. PROJECT SPOTLIGHT: LITERACY CENTERS IN PAKISTAN

Since 2002, the Rotary Club of Jhang Saddar, Punjab, Pakistan, in District 3272 (Afghanistan; Pakistan), has hosted literacy centers, providing basic courses in Urdu (the national language of Pakistan) throughout Jhang and the surrounding region. Its greatest success has been in the education of women. Since the project's inception, 2,296 women have taken the basic literacy course, and 2,037 of them have passed. So far, 105 courses for women have been offered, with classes meeting daily for three months. Facilitators are hired by the club and trained by New Century Education, and the courses are fully funded by Rotarians, at a cost of US\$8 per student. The Jhang Saddar club formed a committee to oversee the implementation of the program and monitor its success. According to the club, it is the type of project that can be easily replicated anywhere with low adult literacy rates. Club members hope that when literacy takes root in a family, it will spread.
