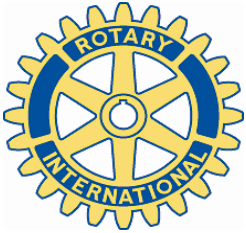

She received a Masters in Social Work in 1979 from the University of Maryland in Administration and Social Welfare Policy. Following graduation, Carolyn was selected into the prestigious Presidential Fellowship Program and served on the White House Conference on Families. In 1983 she was appointed as a technical advisor to the White House Commission on Social Security Reform chaired by Alan Greenspan. During the time she served as Assistant Counsel to the Subcommittee on Social Security and Staff Director of the Subcommittee on Public Assistance and Unemployment Compensation, and for the Committee on Ways and Means in the U.S. House of Representatives. She is married to Judge Terry Ketchel and they have two sons. After the birth of their first child, Ketchel and her husband moved to Fort Walton Beach. Carolyn returned to school at Florida State University and finished the coursework necessary to receive her license in Clinical Social Work. She has worked in private family counseling in various community settings. Carolyn worked for Congressman Jeff Miller and Senator Don Gaetz as a Senior Legislative Aide. Carolyn also hosts a radio program on WPSM 91.1, *A Christian Perspective*. Carolyn came to Catholic Charities in 2007. She brings a broad and varied knowledge of social programs and social policy on federal, state and local levels to Catholic Charities.

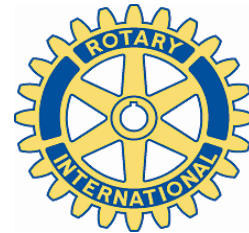
THE OBJECT OF ROTARY
