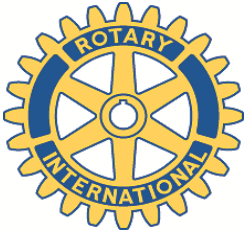

Dr. Julie McNabb was selected as the Chief Executive Officer of Horizons of Okaloosa County, Inc. in January, 2009. She had begun working at Horizons in 1997 after moving back to this area from northern Virginia. She was originally hired at Horizons in 1997 as a program manager and was later promoted to Chief Operation Officer.
