Ray Sansom has a Bachelor of Science degree in political science from Florida State University and a Master Degree in educational leadership from the University of West Florida.

Sansom is the vice president for human resources and administration for The Rader Group, which manages charter schools for at-risk students.

Sansom was principal of the Learning Academy of Santa Rosa, a 6th through 12th grade drop-out prevention school in Santa Rosa County. He also served as a dean of students at the Okaloosa Academy, a drop-out prevention school for middle and high school students in Okaloosa County.

Prior to that, Sansom served as the director of community affairs and executive director of the Okaloosa Public Schools Foundation for the Okaloosa School District from 2001 to 2008.

Sansom is a former Okaloosa County Commissioner, having served on the board from 1992 to 2000. He served as commission chairman for four years. In 2002, Sansom was elected to the Florida House of Representatives. In 2008, he became the 84th Florida Speaker of the House.

Lattimore soon became a central figure in the Red Scare hysteria created by McCarthy's reckless charges and accusations.

On this day in 1953, American medical researcher Dr. Jonas Salk announces on a national radio show that he has successfully tested a vaccine against poliomyelitis, the virus that causes the crippling disease of polio.

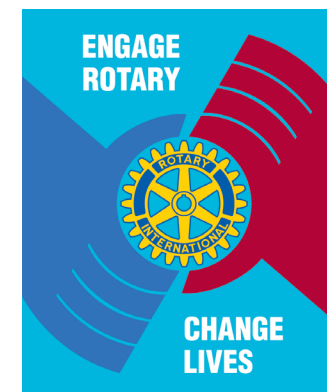
